- * the effect humans have on the environment and vice versa

4. migration-

* the movement of people from one country to another

- 5. push factors-
- * things that cause people to move away from a certain location

6. pull factors-

* things that attract people to a certain location

7. slavery-

- * A cruel system where people are bought and sold and made to work without pay
- 8. Underground Railroad- * a secret system of routes, safe places, and people that helped slaves escape to freedom in the North or Canada
